32	This amendment deletes the authority of the Commissioner of
34	Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to enter into an arrangement with the State Tax Assessor to include fishing and hunting licenses in
36	state individual income tax booklets. The amendment also allows the State Tax Assessor to undertake, by arrangement with another
38	agency of the State, to provide revenue collection services for that agency after consultation with the joint standing committee
