
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 623, L.D. 1826, Bill, "An Act to Change the Name of the Bureau of Taxation and to Allow Other Agencies of the State to Benefit from Its Services"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision of the bill that allows the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to allow fishing and hunting license applications to be included in state individual income tax booklets.
