

SENATE AMENDMENT "*B*" to S.P. 623, L.D. 1826, Bill, "An Act to Change the Name of the Bureau of Taxation and to Allow Other Agencies of the State to Benefit from Its Services"

Amend the bill in section 8 in that part designated "*§112.*" in subsection 9 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 5, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "if prior approval of the arrangement has been obtained from" and inserting in its place the following: 'after consultation with'
