SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1285, L.D. 1830, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funding for Mental Retardation Day Services for Nonclass Members"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriations contained in the bill by \$450,000 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$200,000 in fiscal year 1998-99.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment reduces the amount appropriated for day services to people with mental retardation who are not class members. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
