HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1287, L.D. 1832, "Resolve, to Establish the Task Force to Study Strategies to Support Parents as Children's First Teachers"

Amend the amendment in the first indented paragraph after the title in the last line (page 1, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "20" and inserting in its place the following: '16'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the first indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Two Legislators jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House;'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th paragraphs before the fiscal note and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of sections 7 and 8 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That the legislative members of the task force are entitled to legislative per diem and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses upon application to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council; and be it further

2 Sec. 8. Meetings. Resolved: That the task force may meet up to 4 times; and be it further

4 Sec. 9. Report. Resolved: That the task force shall submit to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs, with a copy to the Governor, a report of its findings, including 6 any necessary implementing legislation no later than December 1, 8 1997. If the task force requires an extension, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension; and be it 10 further

12 Sec. 10. Budget authorization. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Human Services shall utilize the department's existing 14 budgeted resources to review and report on the matters pursuant to section 5 of this resolve. The commissioner may accept and 16 administer any outside funds contributed to support the work of the task force; and be it further

18 Sec. 11. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are 20 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
