HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1291, L.D. 1836, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate Delegation of the Federal Waste Discharge Permitting Program"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the first indented paragraph on page 2 and before the 2nd indented paragraph before the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:


'Further amend the bill by striking out all of Part B.'

**FISCAL NOTE**

The deletion of all fee changes to the Maine Environmental Protection Fund and of all increased allocations to the Department of Environmental Protection will significantly reduce the likelihood that the federal government will decide to delegate the Federal Discharge Licensing and Management Program to the State of Maine.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes all revisions to the existing fee system from the committee amendment and the bill.
