SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1291, L.D. 1836, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate Delegation of the Federal Waste Discharge Permitting Program"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following new Part:


PART C

Sec. C-1. Rights not affected. Nothing in this Act may be construed to affect the terms of "An Act to Implement the Maine Indian Claims Settlement."

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
