HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1292, L.D. 1837, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Shellfish Management Committees to Determine Fees for Clam Licenses"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B by inserting at the end the following: 'This paragraph is repealed June 30, 1998.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6671, sub-§3-A, ¶B-1 is enacted to read:

B-1. A shellfish conservation ordinance may fix license fees. The fee for a nonresident license may not be more than 1 1/2 times the resident fee. This paragraph takes effect July 1, 1998.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

This amendment provides that beginning July 1, 1998 the maximum fee for a nonresident municipal shellfish license is 1 1/2 times the resident fee. The bill sets the maximum fee at twice the resident fee.
