
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1292, L.D. 1837, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Shellfish Management Committees to Determine Fees for Clam Licenses"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph B and inserting in its place the following:

'B. A shellfish conservation ordinance may fix license fees. The fee for a ~~resident license may not exceed \$200~~ and ~~the fee for~~ a nonresident license may be not more than twice 1 1/2 times the resident fee.'

SUMMARY

This amendment sets the maximum fee for a nonresident municipal shellfish license at 1 1/2 times the resident fee. The bill sets the maximum fee at twice the resident fee.
