32	Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda
34	are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.
36	If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue
38	is estimated to be \$38,466,250 with principal payments of \$25,000,000 and interest payments of approximately \$13,466,250.
