	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
2	Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
4	Whereas, the unemployment compensation office located in
6	Fort Kent is being closed; and
8	Whereas, this legislation directs the Department of Labor to transfer appropriate functions and personnel to the office that
10	houses the employment security office in Fort Kent; and
12	Whereas, it is essential that this transfer occur as soon as the space becomes available to minimize the adverse economic
14	impact on the Fort Kent area; and
1.6	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
18	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
20	safety; now, therefore, be it
22	Sec. 1. Transfer of functions and personnel. Resolved: That the Department of Labor shall transfer appropriate functions and
24	personnel, including, but not limited to, a Job Service office, to the office that houses the unemployment compensation office in
26	Fort Kent.
28	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.
