COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1303, L.D. 1846, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit the Opening of Liquor Stores on the Maine Turnpike"

Amend the bill in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd indented paragraphs (page 1, lines 5 to 10 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Whereas, it is imperative that this Act take effect prior to the expiration of the 90-day period to ensure that a liquor store is not located or operated on the Maine Turnpike or any exit or entrance of the Maine Turnpike; and'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to June 26, 1997.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Prohibiting the State from opening discount liquor stores on the Maine Turnpike may reduce the Department of Administrative and Financial Services' ability to generate the level of General Fund revenue projected for fiscal year 1998-99 and subsequent fiscal years.'
