SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1304, L.D. 1847, Bill, "An Act to Modify the Retirement Laws for the 38th Training Troop of the Maine State Police"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

20

Sec. 4. Effective date. Those sections of this Act that amend the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 17708, subsections 2 and 3 and Title 5, section 17851, subsection 4 take effect when the Legislature appropriates funds to implement these sections.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment provides that the sections of the bill that change the cutoff date for eligibility for retirement benefits after 20 years of creditable service for state police officers to September 16, 1984 take effect when the Legislature appropriates funds to implement these sections.
