SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 633, L.D. 1850, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Town of Chester to Annex a Certain Parcel of Land"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment adds a mandate preamble to the bill and exempts the State from the mandate funding requirement.
