premises" and inserting in its place the following: 'lands and
waters'

Further amend the bill in section 13 in that part designated
"~~§1880.~~" in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the next to
last line (page 61, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "and visible from the watercourse"

"~~§1894.~~" in the 4th paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 68,
lines 46 and 47 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "lands,


