SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 637, L.D. 1854, Bill, "An Act
to Establish the Maine Economic Improvement Fund"

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of that part
designated "S948."


Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated
"S949." in the first line (page 3, line 20 in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "949" and inserting in its place the
following: '948'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates the provision that requires annual
transfers from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund and
General Fund appropriations to the Maine Economic Improvement
Fund.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision in the bill that
provided as one funding mechanism for the Maine Economic
Improvement Fund, annual transfers from the unappropriated
surplus of the General Fund and also takes out language requiring
General Fund appropriations to the fund.
