## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §314-A, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

 9. Governmental capacity. For the purposes of Title 30,
6 section 6208, a federally recognized Indian tribe operating high-stakes beano or high-stakes bingo under this section is
8 operating in its governmental capacity.

## **SUMMARY**

14 This bill provides that a federally recognized Indian tribe that operates high-stakes beano or high-stakes bingo is operating 16 in the tribe's governmental capacity. When operating in a governmental capacity, the tribe is not subject to taxation.
