SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 641, L.D. 1863, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Major Investments in Shipbuilding Facilities and to Encourage the Preservation of Jobs"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the last indented paragraph (page 2, lines 42 to 51 in amendment) and on page 3 by striking out all of the first indented paragraph (page 3, lines 2 to 4 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§6851.~~" by striking out all of subsections 8 and 9 and inserting in their place the following:

'8. Qualified employee. "Qualified employee" means a person:

A. Who is a full-time employee of the applicant;

B. Whose income from that employment is taxable under Title 36, chapter 803;

C. For whom a retirement program is provided subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, 29 United States Code, Sections 101 to 1461, as amended;

D. For whom group health insurance is provided; and

E. Whose income calculated on a calendar year basis is greater than the average annual per capita income in the State.'
