2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

	Whereas, the Harness Racing Task Force, established by
6	Executive Order No. 6 95/96, has recommended that the position of full-time chair of the State Harness Racing Commission be
8	replaced with an executive director position; and
10	Whereas, the position of full-time chair has been vacant since July 1995; and
12	Whomas the Hanness Dasing Task Forge has determined that
14	Whereas, the Harness Racing Task Force has determined that the leadership needs of the State Harness Racing Commission must be met immediately in order for issues confronting the harness
