COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1315, L.D. 1866, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Maine Harness Racing Commission to Issue Conditional Licenses"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 1, lines 5 to 7 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Conditions. The commission may impose conditions on a license if one or more of the criteria established in this section are not met at the time the license is issued, but may be brought into compliance within a time period during the licensing year.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the commission may place conditions on a license based on the criteria established in statute.
