Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §929-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 410,
Pt. MMM, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

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3. Appointments. Members appointed to the council serve a
3-year term.

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SUMMARY

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This bill removes obsolete references to initial
appointments and removes the restriction on members serving for
more than one 3-year term.

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
