HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 653, L.D. 1874, Bill, "An Act to Establish Limitations on Swine-feeding Operations"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S4204~~." in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the first line (page 6, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "50" and inserting in its place the following: '100'

SUMMARY

Committee Amendment "A" requires farms that confine or feed 50 or more animal units to have a nutrient management plan. This amendment increases the number of animal units necessitating a nutrient management plan to 100 or more.
