
HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 662, L.D. 1882, Bill, "An Act Concerning Acceptance of Campaign Contributions during Legislative Sessions"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in paragraph A in the 3rd line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting in its place the following: '∟' and in the last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "1012" the following: 'and the term "employee" has the same meaning as in section 1012'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 17 and 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or employer" and inserting in its place the following: ', employer or employee' and in the 6th line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or employer" and inserting in its place the following: ', employer or employee'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds employees to the list of people that are prohibited from contributing to a Legislator's campaign during a legislative session.
