HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 663, L.D. 1883, Bill, "An Act to Ask Voters in a Referendum Whether One Travel Lane in Each Direction Should be Added to the Maine Turnpike, Paid for by Turnpike Tolls, to Reduce Accidents and Congestion"

Amend the bill in Part B in section 2 in the question in the last line (page 2, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", to reduce accidents and congestion"
