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Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

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FISCAL NOTE

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The increase of salaries will increase the operating costs of Kennebec County. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.

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SUMMARY

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This bill, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government, increases the salaries of certain county officers and applies retroactively to January 1, 1996 and adds a fiscal note.
