Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1102, sub-§1-A, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 4 119, $\S3$, is amended to read: 6 Public service corporations. 1-A. Α public service corporation or an employee of a public service corporation making electrical installations in the course of the 8 employee's employment, including electrical installations made on facilities owned by a customer, but only to the extent the electrical 10 installations are made in the course of rendering a service subject to regulation by the Public Utilities Commission or the 12 Federal Communications Commission; 14 SUMMARY 16 18 This bill clarifies that the exception for public service corporations to the laws regarding licensing of electricians 20 applies to electrical installations made on facilities owned by a customer.
