SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1362, L.D. 1913, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Confidentiality of Public Employee Information"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Appropriates funds for 90% of the additional local costs associated with redacting employees' names from certain files. The Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall distribute these funds pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5685. Amounts not required to fund 90% of the local costs associated with this Act must lapse to the General Fund.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
fiscal note and inserting in its place:

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$100

This bill provides a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, State Mandates program of \$100 in fiscal year 1998-99 to provide additional funds for 90% of the local costs associated with redacting employees' names from certain records. The department can absorb the minor additional costs associated with meeting the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5685 to distribute these funds for this state mandate.'

SUMMARY

This amendment includes a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services of \$100 in fiscal year 1998-99 to provide additional funds for the local costs associated with deleting references to an employee's name from certain files.
