SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1370, L.D. 1920, Bill, "An Act to Promote Competitiveness Regarding the Sale of Recreational Vehicles by Allowing Better Discounts"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 and before the summary the following:

'Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §1434, sub-§3, ¶R, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 427, §2, is amended by amending subparagraph (1) to read:

(1) All unsold and unaltered new model recreational vehicle inventory of the current model year and the previous model ~~years~~ year purchased from the manufacturer;'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the intent of the law by limiting the obligation of the manufacturer of recreational vehicles to repurchase inventory of a terminated dealer to the current model year and the model year immediately preceding the current year.
