4. License fee. The fee for a resident expanded archery deer hunting license is \$49 \$20. The fee for a nonresident expanded archery deer hunting license is \$80 \$40. A person 10 years of age or older and under 16 years of age may hunt with a bow and arrow during the expanded archery deer hunting season if that person possesses a valid junior hunting license.
