22	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
24	'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local
26	units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does
28	not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,
30	two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'
32	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the

36	FISCAL NOTE

40	This bill requires certain municipalities to open their polling place earlier on election day. This requirement represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of
42	Maine. Forty-seven municipalities have a population of 6,000 or
44	more. Of the 47, 22 municipalities are not in compliance. The estimated cost of this mandate for these municipalities is \$1,938 per election (General and Primary), an average of \$88.10 per
46	election for each municipality. The remaining 25 municipalities, although in compliance, are also eligible for reimbursement for
48	this state mandate. The estimated costs for these municipalities is \$12,500 per election based on average cost of \$250 per hour
