HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1397, L.D. 1950, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and Changes to Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1998 and June 30, 1999"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part DDD the following:

PART EEE

Sec. EEE-1. 5 MRSA §1513, sub-§1-K is enacted to read:

1-K. Transfer from Maine Rainy Day Fund. Notwithstanding subsection 2 and section 1585, an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 must be transferred from the available balance in the Maine Rainy Day Fund to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund no later than June 30, 1999.

Sec. EEE-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

private funding. Up to 20% of this

preservation, as determined by the Land for


