HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1397, L.D. 1950, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and Changes to Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1998 and June 30, 1999"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part DDD the following:

**PART EEE**

**Sec. EEE-1. 5 MRSA §1513, sub-§1-K is enacted to read:**

1-K. Transfer from Maine Rainy Day Fund; out-of-district placements. Notwithstanding subsection 2 and section 1585, an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 may be transferred from the available balance in the Maine Rainy Day Fund to the Department of Education for out-of-district placements to be made available by financial order, upon the recommendation of the State Budget Officer and approval of the Governor.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 1997-98 and fiscal year 1998-99.
