**PART EEE**

28 **Sec. EEE-1. 36 MRSA §6652, sub-§1-C is enacted to read:**

30 1-C. Reimbursement for property first eligible after April  
32 1, 1999. For property that first becomes eligible for  
34 reimbursement under this chapter after April 1, 1999, the amount  
of reimbursement to which the claimant is entitled is limited to  
90% of the taxes paid with regard to that property.'

36 Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering  
38 any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read  
consecutively.

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
