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FISCAL NOTE

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The Bureau of Revenue Services does not currently have the economic modeling capability to comply with the this bill. requested requirements in The bureau has lease-purchase approval as part of the Governor's proposed 1998-1999 supplemental budget, LD 1950, as amended with Bureau of the Budget changes submitted on January 28, 1998. If this lease-purchase is approved by the Legislature, the Bureau of Revenue Services will be able to comply with these reporting requirements without additional resources.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment changes the date of the first revenue incidence report to July 1, 1999 and requires the Bureau of Revenue Services, when determining the incidence of taxes, to subtract the amount of taxes returned directly to taxpayers through tax relief programs from the amount of revenues collected. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
