This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$36,400 12 in fiscal year 1998-99 for expanded services for deaf and hard of hearing persons served by the Rehabilitation Services program 14 within the Department of Labor.

16 This bill authorizes the Department of Labor to utilize other available resources to achieve an expansion of services for 18 deaf and hard of hearing persons. The department has approximately \$20,000 in previously allocated federal funds that 20 can be used for this purpose in fiscal year 1997-98 and the same amount in fiscal year 1998-99.'

SUMMARY

26 This amendment eliminates the General Fund appropriation for fiscal year 1997-98 and reduces the General Fund appropriation 28 for fiscal year 1998-99 to \$36,400. The amendment also authorizes the Department of Labor to utilize other available 30 resources to achieve an expansion of services for the deaf and hard of hearing. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the 32 bill.
