Presented by Senator TREAT of Kennebec. Cosponsored by Senator LaFOUNTAIN of York, Representatives: JONES of Greenville, KERR of Old Orchard Beach, THOMPSON of Naples, WATSON of Farmingdale. Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, recent funding that provided interpretive services required by state law for those people who are deaf or hard of hearing and are dealing with state agencies or the judicial system has been depleted well before the end of each fiscal year; and

Whereas, to comply with the requirements of state law it is 12 necessary to appropriate additional funds for the needed interpretive services; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
