

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 727, L.D. 1969, Bill, "An Act to Protect Students of Barbering, Cosmetology and Other Proprietary Schools"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in that part designated "**§14246.**" in subsection 1 in the 9th line (page 4, line 12 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "seq." the following: 'the bond must be in favor of the Finance Authority of Maine. For all other applicants.'

This amendment corrects language in section 10 of Committee Amendment "A" to clarify the proper holder of the required bond.
