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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 727, L.D. 1969, Bill, "An Act to Protect Students of Barbering, Cosmetology and Other Proprietary Schools"

Amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "§14211-A." in subsection 4 by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence (page 4, lines 19 to 23 in L.D.)

SUMMARY

This amendment removes references to certain functions of the board that it no longer performs and therefore the board does not require provisions for closing board meetings while performing those functions. The provisions of the freedom of access laws, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, chapter 13, subchapter I, continue to apply to the board.
