HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT A to H.P. 1408, L.D. 1972, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Interagency Committee on Outdoor Trash Burning"

Amend the amendment in the first blocked paragraph after the title (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "dwelling." the following: 'The director may consider the criteria set forth in this paragraph only if the municipality in which the proposed burning is located has adopted an ordinance specifying these criteria for out-of-door burning.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that a forest ranger or fire warden may consider the additional criteria for issuing a permit for outdoor burning only if the municipality in which the property is located has adopted an ordinance specifying the additional criteria.
