HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1408, L.D. 1972, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Interagency Committee on Outdoor Trash Burning"

Amend the amendment in the first blocked paragraph after the title (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "dwelling." the following: 'The person issuing the permit may consider the criteria set forth in this paragraph only if the municipality in which the proposed burning is located has adopted an ordinance specifying these criteria for out-of-door burning.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the Director of the Bureau of Forestry or a forest ranger or fire warden delegated by the director may consider the additional criteria for issuing a permit for out-of-door burning only if the municipality in which the property is located has adopted an ordinance specifying the additional criteria.
