COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1413, L.D. 1977, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Hazardous Occupations Provisions of the Child Labor Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 and before the summary the following:

'Sec. 2. Committee briefing. Before providing notice of or holding a hearing on proposed rules, as required by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II, the Director of the Bureau of Labor Standards shall brief the joint standing committee of the legislature having jurisdiction over labor matters on the substance of the rules proposed to comply with Title 26, section 772.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Labor will incur some minor additional costs to adopt certain rules pertaining to hazardous occupations and to brief the Legislature on the proposed rules. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Director of the Bureau of Labor Standards to brief the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over labor matters on the proposed rules regarding hazardous occupations for minors.
