COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1418, L.D. 1982, Bill, "An Act to Appropriate Funds to Build a Memorial and to Name a Highway in Burnham in Honor of Medal of Honor Recipient Corporal Clair Goodblood"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Name a Highway in Burnham in Honor of Medal of Honor Recipient Corporal Clair Goodblood'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor additional cost to provide signage or erect a plaque. These costs can be absorbed within the Department of Transportation's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes from the bill a General Fund appropriation to partially fund the construction of a memorial to Corporal Clair Goodblood. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
