Whereas,** Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6 Whereas, a new bridge has been built in Palmyra on Route 2 6 that crosses the Sebasticook River; and

8 Whereas, the bridge is currently unnamed and it is necessary that this new bridge have a designation for identification 10 purposes; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore, be it

18 Sec. 1. Naming the Route 2 Palmyra Bridge. Resolved: That the new bridge constructed on Route 2 in Palmyra crossing the
20 Sebasticook River be named in memory of Maine State Trooper Thomas Merry.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

This resolve names the newly constructed bridge on Route 2 30 in Palmyra in memory of Maine State Trooper Thomas Merry.
