SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1431, L.D. 1995, Bill, "An Act to Appropriate Funds for Library Resource Sharing and for Acquisitions for the Maine State Library"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1 to 4.

Further amend the amendment in section 5 by striking out all of lines 5 to 11 (page 2, lines 21 to 29 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in section 5 by striking out all of the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 40 and 41 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the amendment by \$1,200,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 by eliminating the General Fund appropriation to the Maine State Library for the Library Resource Sharing and Support program.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the portions of the committee amendment creating a nonlapsing fund within the Maine State Library to support public libraries and library resource sharing. It also removes the \$1,200,000 General Fund appropriation provided for that purpose.
