This resolve includes a General Fund appropriation of \$5,000 and a Federal Expenditure Fund allocation of \$5,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the Department of Human Services to contract for assistance in performing the required audit.

The Department of Education will incur some minor additional costs to assist the Department of Human Services in its audit of certain programs and in the preparation of the report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

18 This amendment replaces the bill and changes it to a resolve. It requires a report on Medicaid services provided in 20 or by school administrative units, state intermediate educational units and the Child Development Services System. It also adds an 22 appropriation, an allocation and a fiscal note.
