COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1434, L.D. 1998, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Cap on the Total Acreage of Aquaculture Leases That May Be Held by One Person"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Increasing the cap on the total acreage of aquaculture leases that may be held by one person will increase future General Fund revenues collected by the Department of Marine Resources from lease payments. These increased revenues will begin to be collected in fiscal year 2000-01 and may be as much as \$20,000 annually.

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
