SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1434, L.D. 1998, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Cap on the Total Acreage of Aquaculture Leases That May Be Held by One Person"

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph B in subparagraph (3) in the first line (page 1, line 45 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "; and" and inserting in its place the following: '; and'


Further amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph B in subparagraph (4) in the last line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "250 acres." and inserting in its place the following: '250 acres; and'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph B by inserting after subparagraph (4) the following:

'(5) The transfer does not result in a total of more than 1,000 acres of aquaculture leases issued for Cobscook Bay in Washington County.'

SUMMARY

This amendment limits to 1,000 acres the total of all aquaculture leases that may be issued for Cobscook Bay in Washington County.
