HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1440, L.D. 2004, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Long-term Funding of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station Research Farms Connected with Land Grant Colleges"

Amend the amendment on page 4 by striking out all of the 3rd indented paragraph from the end (page 4, lines 36 to 39 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "~~§125.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph G (page 4, lines 22 to 25 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'G. Two members of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agricultural matters, one appointed by the President of the Senate and one appointed by the Speaker of the House.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House each shall appoint one member of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agricultural matters to the Board of Agriculture established within the University of Maine. The bill provides that the President and the Speaker shall jointly appoint these members.
