24	Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 17 in L.D.)
26 28	Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: " <u>AGRICULTURE</u> " the following: ' <u>AND</u> '
30 32	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 (page 1, lines 35 to 50 and page 2, lines 1 to 30 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

38	§121. Maine Agricultural Experiment Station
40	1. Establishment. The department of the University of
42	Maine System known and designated as the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station, referred to in this section as the "station,"
44	established at the University of Maine at Orono in connection with the university and under the direction of the university,
46	the director and the Board of Agriculture, for the purpose of carrying into effect an Act of the Congress of the United States,

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2 2. Director. The President of the University of Maine at Orono, in consultation with the Board of Agriculture, shall appoint for a term of 5 years the Director of the Maine 4 Agricultural Experiment Station, referred to in this section as 6 the "director." After the term has expired, the director is eligible for reappointment. The director may be removed by the 8 President of the University of Maine at Orono, in consultation with the Board of Agriculture, for cause. The director shall 10 work with the Board of Agriculture to oversee the work of the university faculty at the station. The director of the station is the executive and administrative officer of the station and 12 shall exercise supervision, direction and control over the 14 station in accordance with the programs and policies of the University of Maine System and those established by the Board of Agriculture.' 16

18 Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§122." by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 40 to 43 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'The Director of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station shall-have, 22 with the agreement of the Board of Agriculture, has the general supervision, management and control of said-farm those farms and 24 of all investigations thereon. The board and the director shall seek agreement on all issues. In the event that agreement can 26 not be reached, final authority rests with the director.'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "\$123." by inserting at the end the following 2 new sentences: The board and the director shall seek agreement on all issues. In the event that agreement can not be reached, final authority rests with the director.'

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Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "§125." by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 3, lines 16 to 34 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

б Establishment; duties. The Board of Agriculture, '<u>1.</u> referred to in this section as the "board," as established in Title 5, section 12004-G, subsection 4-A, is created within the 8 University of Maine System. The board shall advise the Chancellor of the University of Maine System and the President of 10 the University of Maine at Orono on matters concerning the 12 operation and management of agricultural research conducted by the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station and university 14 farm-based programs, including those of the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Service. The board's duties are limited to 16 advising the chancellor and the president on research and programs relating to agriculture. The board does not advise the Director of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station or have a 18 role in the operation of research and programs within the Maine 20 Agricultural Experiment Station that relate to forestry, wildlife, or fisheries and aquaculture. The board shall assist 22 the chancellor and the president in articulating the mission of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station as it pertains to 24 agriculture. The director, with the agreement of the board, shall develop a budget for the station. The board and the 26 director shall seek agreement on all issues. In the event that agreement can not be reached, final authority rests with the 28 director. The board may not interfere with funding and grants for commodity research programs brought to the University of 30 Maine System directly or through the efforts of commodity groups. The board shall respect the expertise of the various commodity groups and shall maintain the integrity of the research 32 being recommended and reviewed by specific commodity groups. The 34 board shall assist in the coordination of activities with commodity groups interested in or supporting agricultural The board shall consult with the following 36 research. agricultural commodity advisory committees on agricultural 38 research and extension priorities:

40 <u>A. The University of Maine System Wild Blueberry Advisory</u> Committee; and

B. The Potato Marketing Improvement Committee.'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated 46 "<u>\$125.</u>" in subsection 2 by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 3, lines 36 to 38 in L.D.) and inserting in its 48 place the following:

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated 46 "<u>\$125.</u>" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph I (page 4, lines 32 to 34 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the 48 following:

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "**§125.**" in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 4, line 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>Station, shall</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>Station shall</u>'

18 Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "<u>\$125.</u>" in subsection 5 in the 4th line (page 5, line 5 in L.D.) 20 by inserting after the following: "<u>Maine</u>" the following '<u>System</u>' and in the 3rd line from the end (page 5, line 9 in L.D.) by 22 inserting after the following: "<u>evaluation of the</u>" the following: '<u>Maine</u>'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated 26 "<u>\$125.</u>" in subsection 5 by inserting at the end the following new sentence: '<u>The Board of Agriculture shall submit annually to the</u> 28 <u>Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System proposals for</u> <u>additional funding for capital building projects at the research</u> 30 farms.'

32 Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "<u>\$125.</u>" in subsection 6 in the 3rd line from the end (page 5, 34 line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>regionalization</u> of extension facilities."

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "<u>\$125.</u>" in subsection 6 by inserting at the end the following new sentence: '<u>The plan developed by the board does not include</u> operations, research and programs relating to forestry, wildlife, aquaculture and fisheries.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

 46 'Sec. 6. Maine Agricultural Experiment Station; budget. Beginning with fiscal year 1999-2000, the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System shall strive to allocate funds for the experimental farms within the Maine Agricultural Experiment
 50 Station at or above the fiscal year 1995-96 funding level. For

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fiscal years 2000-01 to 2001-02, the board of trustees shall strive to increase the funding for each experimental farm by a minimum of 5% per year above that farm's 1995-96 funding. Capital building projects must be funded from within the university facilities management budget.'

Eurther amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency 8 clause (page 5, lines 22 and 23 in L.D.)

10 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read 12 consecutively.

14 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 16

'FISCAL NOTE

20 The additional costs associated with the Board of Agriculture can be absorbed by the University of Maine System 22 utilizing existing budgeted resources.

24 The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to participate in the Board of 26 Agriculture. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

32 The amendment final authority clarifies that for administration of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station 34 rests with the Director of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station. It removes the emergency preamble from the bill and 36 places in unallocated law a directive to the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System regarding funding for the 38 experimental farms within the Maine Agricultural Experiment It clarifies those programs on which the Board of Station. 40 Agriculture is to advise the Chancellor of the University of Maine System and the President of the University of Maine at 42 Orono. It adds to the Board of Agriculture a member to represent a statewide organic farmers and growers association and the 44 Director of the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Service. It removes the directive that the long-range plan 46 developed by the Board of Agriculture include plans for regionalizing extension facilities.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
