SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1441, L.D. 2005, Bill, "An Act to Conform Maine's Safe Drinking Water Laws with the 1996 Amendments of the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in that part designated "~~S2620-C.~~" in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 6, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes the Commissioner of Human Services to adopt rules establishing a permitting process for the public water systems. The committee amendment would make such rules mandatory, constituting a legislative mandate for a permitting process.
